Alexander Petrovich Kudryavtsev**



Professor, PhD in Architecture, Doctor Habilitus of Moscow Architectural Institute (2007), merited architect of Russian Federation, People's architect of Russia Federation, laureate of the prize of the Council of Ministers of the USSR.

Full member of International academy of architecture (Sofia), European Academy of Sciences and Arts (Salzburg), honorary Fellow of American Institute of Architects, honorary member of the French academy of Architecture, Union of architects of Bulgaria, honorary professor and doctor of the universities and academies of Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan.

Awards: merited architect of Russian Federation (1977), laureate of the prize of the Council of Ministers of the USSR (1974), awarded the Badge of Merits on Fatherland (2007), the Badge of Honour (1976), the prize of Moscow (2003).

Born in Moscow in 1937. Graduated Moscow Architectural institute (1958) and Institute of Architecture, Bucharest, Romania (1960). Began working at the Palace of Soviets project board, then at the Central research and experimental project institute of the buildings of entertainment and sport (1964-1977). Since 1977 he has been engaged at MARKHI, 1987 elected as the rector of the Institute. 1989-92 peoples deputy of the USSR. 1999 elected President of Russian academy of architecture and construction sciences (RAACS). Took part in architectural teams projecting a number of civil buildings and complexes, author of more than 150 scientific publications on theory and contemporary history of national and foreign architecture, methodology of architectural education. Took part in elaboration of the UIA/UNESCO Charter on architectural education

Member of Council on culture and arts by the President of RF (2000-2008), vice-president of the European cultural society. President of the National Trust of the preservation of historical environment.
